Board President, L.A. Gregorash read the waiver to the Board of Education members and the audience as follows:

Let the record reflect that this is the public hearing on the review of the application for waiver or modification of State Board Rules and/or School Code Mandates conducted by the Board of Education of Woodland Community Consolidated School District No. 50, Lake County, Illinois.

The Board will hear public testimony on the application to seek a waiver of ISBE Rule, Title 23, Part 228 Transitional Bilingual Educations, Section 228.30 Establishment of Programs c) 1)...., any person designated to administer a TBE program must hold a valid administrative or supervisory endorsement issued by the State Board of Education in accordance with applicable provisions of 23 Ill. Admn. Code 25 (Certification) and 23 Ill.Code 1 (Public Schools Evaluation, Recognition and Supervision) must hold the bilingual approval or endorsement. On March 30, 31 and April 1, 2010, notice was published in the *Daily*

*Herald and Lake County News Sun* of tonight's public hearing. In addition, written advanced notice was provided to the District's bargaining agents as well as the District's state legislators as required.
