

## PTA Meeting

May 13, 2009

Meeting began at 7:07pm.

- Call to order.
- Recording Secretary (Cheri Blenniss): There are a total of 105 families enrolled in the eScrip Dominick's Fresh Values Card program. The PTA is still pushing for 200 families to sign up for the program and will continue to promote the program next school year.
- Treasurer (Amy Martin): Current balance \$57,786.57 which is overstated by approximately \$13,000 due to an amount owed to Scholastic Books for the Intermediate Book Fair. Presented the final budget proposal for the 2009-2010 school year. Polly Hergenreder requested approval of the proposed budget for the 2009-2010 school year. Tricia Elkinton moved to give approval of the proposed budget. Kerry Winston seconds the motion. The motion was made and carried.
- Primary Vice President (Annie Schladt): No report.
- Elementary East Vice President (Michelle Klemz): Read and passed around several thank you cards to the PTA for a wonderful teacher appreciation week and luncheon. A thank you card from Ann Aldrich to the PTA for the books received from the Book Fair.
- Elementary West Vice President (Polly Hergenreder for Rhonda Nitto): Thank you card was received from the P.E. Department for the teacher appreciation luncheon.
- Intermediate Vice President (Polly Hergenreder for Lisa Gjelsten): No report.
- Middle School Vice President (Polly Hergenreder for Patti Shanders): Several thank you cards were received for the teacher appreciation luncheon.
- President (Polly Hergenreder): Seven individuals were each honored with a \$500 PTA Scholarship including: Michelle Ditmars, Masciel Flores, Lindsay Goad, Brian Kinney, Matthew Kolaczowski, Kristen Lewis and Paul Myles. All recipients were from Warren High School and were unable to attend the PTA meeting due to Warren Honors Night being held at the same time. Artwork for the PTA calendar needs to be turned in by May 18<sup>th</sup>. There were 15 parents in attendance at the PTA morning meeting this morning. Monthly morning PTA meetings will continue next school year. There are still plans to have a back to school Kick Off including family games and a movie night. Details are still being finalized. A committee has been formed to plan the cookbook fundraiser in the fall. Polly inquired with the group in attendance if the PTA evening meeting time should be changed from 7pm to 6:30pm. There was no clear statement from the group. As of now the meeting time will remain at 7pm.
- Market Day (Polly Hergenreder for Celeste Brown): The Uno pizza fund raiser made a huge profit. \$8,459.00 worth of pizzas was sold with a PTA profit of \$2,960.65.
- Proof of Residency (Polly Hergenreder): The PTA will again be at proof of residency selling PTA memberships alongside Spirit Wear, Book Sox and eScrip enrollment.
- Spirit Wear (Kim Stams): Spirit Wear orders will be filled mid to the end of next week. On-line ordering proved to be successful with 15 individuals ordering on-line with a \$500 total sale. Kim is considering adding pictures of the items to the order form. New designs will be available for fall purchase.
- Primary staff showed a thank you video created by Lori Casey and Stacey Anderson thanking the PTA for all the services and monies they provide throughout the year.
- Primary Assistant Principal (Stacey Anderson): Appreciated teacher appreciation week and luncheon.
- Intermediate Assistant Principal (Tim Tyrell): Asked how he can encourage more parents to get involved with the PTA. Polly Hergenreder responded to all of the administrators to include PTA activities in morning announcements and encourage teachers to promote the PTA in their weekly newsletters.

- Primary School Representative (Sharis Sork): Thanked the PTA for use of the popcorn machine this year.
