R is for RESPECT

- Speak highly of your child's teachers and classmates when discussing school with your children.
- Encourage students to care for school property such as library books, assignment books, supplies, etc...
- Communicate with school
- Utilize the same words taught at school in regards to expectations



O is for OWNERSHIP

- Students should complete homework and return it on time- Make the responsibility of homework your child's
- Speak honestly about student behavior issues and good choices
- Encourage child to take pride in every school assignment
- Remind students that they represent their school and their families through their choices

A is for ACCEPTING

- Encourage your child's creativity and individuality within the guidelines of expectations
- Discuss diversity with your child- Teach children about your own culture and those of others
- Talk about why different is good when it comes to a group of people
- Teach children coping skills for dealing with others
- Teach the difference between fair and equal- we do not all need exactly the same things
