What is a Parent Mentor?

By volunteering in a classroom for two hours a day for at least 100 hours, Parent Mentors help close persistent equity gaps in our children's own schools. Together, we support each other to pursue our goals and unite the school community for long-term change.

What do Parent Mentors do?

Parents work one-on-one or in small groups with students who need extra support in the classroom.

Parent Mentors are:

- provided necessary training.
- compensated with a modest stipend.
- offered weekly workshops on professional development skills in academic instruction and leadership.

All parents are welcome! Your citizenship status, level of education, and language skills are not a barrier to your involvement in your child's school. No previous experience is required!
