Agency and Police Interviews

The Superintendent or designee shall manage requests by agency officials, law enforcement officers, school resource officers or other school security personnel to interview students at school through procedures that: (1) recognize individual student rights and privacy, (2) minimize potential disruption, (3) foster a cooperative relationship with public agencies and law enforcement, and (4) comply with State law.
