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Q. Is Woodland Community Consolidated School District #50 considered a 501(c) (3)?

A. No. School districts are not required by the IRS to file 501(c) (3) paperwork. If the grant you are applying for requires 501(c) (3) status the event will need to be partnered with a qualifying 501(c) (3) arm of the school such as the PTA, Woodland Educational Foundation or Wildcat Music Boosters.

Q. I want to apply for a grant that is not listed on this webpage, can I still apply?

A. Absolutely, but we ask that you contact the grant coordinating team prior to starting the grant. We may know already or will take a first look to make sure we meet all of the qualifications.

Q. I would like to apply for a grant in the future but I do not see anything available to choose from?
